Gleaners kitchen and bathroom rules for campers No kitchen use between 8:00 – 11:00 a.m

- A camper's fridge is available and identified in the kitchen and it is expected that you NOT use the other one. You will have only the use of the fridge freezer unless permission is given by the kitchen staff.
- Any food items that campers need shall be supplied by them and not The Gleaners organization.
- When the kitchen facilities are used by the campers, any mess is to be cleaned up immediately after use. This includes sweeping or mopping if you specifically have made the mess. Leave the facility as you find it.
- Bathroom facilities are available with the expectation that you wipe down the showers and leave it as clean as when you enter.
- Short showers please because of the septic system. Bring your own towels.
- All campers toiletries will be kept in their bags or tents, not in the kitchen or bathrooms as we are not able to keep watch over nor do we have the room in the kitchen/lunch room area for storage of camping or personal items.
- Please use available cupboard in kitchen area by the door for storing food items or kitchen use items. Lunch room space is limited so please keep the floor free of campers items.
- There will be a close line available outside the tenting area for hanging swim wear/towels to dry.
- Laundry machines are available in the kitchen but must be done in the allotted hours of kitchen use.
- The Gleaners will try to accommodate your needs as campers, but it is a volunteer organization and we have a limited supply of amenities on site so come prepared. Everything we have in the kitchen is donated and not always a plentiful supply.
- If you have small children along, YOU are expected to abide by the rules as any other camper does. The kitchen, and or plant floor, is not a place for

your child to play. You will be expected to watch over them in your own camping area. This is not a safe area for small ones.

There are beaches within a short drive and Vernon city is within a 20 minute drive.

We have golf courses available and hiking galore!

Bears are in abundant supply in the plant area so be wise with your food storage and where you walk. They love the corn field that is beside the plant. Do not allow small children alone to wander about at night or early morning. Be bear aware!
